<p align="center"><u>RE</u></p> <p>Why is a Synagogue a sacred building to Jewish people?</p> <p>Watch the BBC video about Shabbat and look at the Synagogue resources on Class Dojo. Write three questions about what you have learnt.</p> <p>Can you label the important artefacts that are found inside a Synagogue? See activity sheet. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/clips/zcfgkqt</p>	<p align="center"><u>Physical Activity</u></p> <p>Hit the button Play in a large space (garden, park, playground, beach). Put a ball as a target about 2 metres away. Throw or roll your ball to get it close to the target. If your ball is closest, you win! Now take a giant step back and throw from there. Can you still hit the target from far away?</p> <p>Follow my family Each person thinks of an easy move. For example, march on the spot, star jump, touch toes, squat, side bend. Stand in a circle. The first person does their move for 10 seconds. The second person copies that move then adds their own move. The third person copies both moves then adds their own - and so on. Go around the circle again. Each person does a new move. How many moves can you do?</p>	<p align="center"><u>Spelling/Reading/Phonics</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Look at the Year 1 word list that was sent out - pick 10 to learn on Monday and try to practise every day - see if you can get 10/10 on Friday! <p align="center"><u>English- Fairy Tales</u></p> <p>Read the story of The Three Billy Goats Gruff and answer the comprehension questions. Build a bridge and act out the story. Write a letter to the troll encouraging him to stop being so mean. There are three different levels of reading tasks, so choose which one you feel is the best fit. Activity sheet/ word mat and powerpoint to assist.</p> 	<p align="center"><u>Maths</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Look at sharing/ grouping/ division this week. As well as the worksheet provided, make sure that you use everyday household objects to share out or group. Continue to do it throughout the week. Focus on sharing between 2 first then 5 then 10 as this connects with the times tables they have been learning. Look out for Kahoot quiz on sharing later in the week! Don't forget to go on maths shed or TTRS and complete number bonds to 10 and 20.
